Dear Resident,

Marbletown is fortunate to be a part of Hudson Valley Community Power (HVCP), a program that works to find the best energy opportunities for its participating communities. Through the HVCP community choice aggregation program, we have renewable electricity at a lower rate with two years of price certainty for residents. Now HVCP is offering a limited number of spaces on local community solar farms which will enable you to subscribe and save up to 10% on your electricity costs annually in addition to your CCA savings. The current vetted and selected solar farm partner is Nexamp, which owns and operates projects in the Hudson Valley.

Here's how it works; when you sign up through Hudson Valley Community Power, Nexamp allocates your share of the solar farm based on your annual electricity usage. Your share adds clean, solar energy to the grid, earning you credits on your Central Hudson utility bill. Nexamp bills you for these credits at a 10% discount and you save on your annual electricity cost. There are no upfront fees, no long-term contracts, and no need to install solar panels on your property.

The program also generates a municipal sustainability fund of \$50 per enrolment through HVCP. After a community meeting discussing possible projects for the fund in September, the council has chosen to dedicate it towards walk and bike projects that build towards the ultimate goal of a complete off-road connection between Stone Ridge and High Falls.

Please consider going to the website and opting in to both secure personal savings, support local renewable energy and help Marbletown raise funds.
