Dear Town of Rhinebeck Resident,

The Town of Rhinebeck is pleased to announce our participation in Hudson Valley Community Power, a Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) program administered by Joule Community Power, a division of Joule Assets, Inc., that puts control of energy supply choices into local hands. Through a competitive procurement process Direct Energy Services, LLC has been selected to replace Central Hudson as the default supplier of electricity for residential and small-commercial accounts within our community. We have chosen 100% renewable supply as the default product offering for our community, but you have the choice to opt-down to a 50% renewable or standard supply option by contacting Hudson Valley Community Power at (845) 859-9099 or info@hudsonvalleycommunitypower.com.

All eligible residential and small-commercial electricity customers will be automatically enrolled in the 100% renewable supply product beginning with the bill cycle following July 1, 2023 and will be able to continue to receive the CCA program price of \$0.12240/kWh through June 30, 2025. You may cancel at any time with no fee or penalty.

Below is a comparison of Central Hudson electricity supply pricing with the CCA program pricing. While this is not indicative of pricing going forward, it does provide a basis for comparison of standard supply offerings. If you choose the 100% renewable product offering, you will pay a premium of \$0.00287 for this product over the utility standard product pricing, however, you will be contributing to NYS clean energy goals.
